Project plans are to be seen as a model but are not expected to be real-life implemented.

The health care leadership project plan summary should include a description of the project, including objectives, measurements of success, potential stakeholders and a project timeline. Please prepare your project plan in a separate Word document. Essay length should not exceed two pages. Format single spaced with a minimum 11-point font using Calibri, Times New Roman or Arial. Charts and tables may be used but are not required.

To support this individual in gaining professional experience, the winner will be expected to present a comprehensive overview of their completed project during a one-hour presentation, including how the mock project could be executed, to the BCBSND Caring Foundation staff and Board of Directors upon completion of their project.

The award funds will be distributed in two \$2,500 payments, the first payment upon notification of award and the second payment at the completion of the final project. Failure to present a completed project to the Caring Foundation staff and Board of Directors will cancel the final \$2,500 payment.
