**Table A: Usual Maximum Medically Necessary Quantity of Supplies**

Insertion tray with drainage bag with indwelling catheter, Foley-type, 2-way, latex with coating (A4311)	1	
Insertion tray without drainage bag with indwelling catheter, Foley type, 2-way, all silicone (A4312)	1	
Insertion tray without drainage bag with indwelling catheter, Foley type, 3-way, for continuous irrigation (A4313)	1	
Insertion tray with drainage bag with indwelling catheter, Foley type, 2-way latex with coating (Teflon, silicone, silicone elastomer or hydrophilic, etc.) (A4314)	1	
Insertion tray with drainage bag with indwelling catheter, Foley-type, 2-way, all silicone (A4315)	1	
Insertion tray with drainage bag with indwelling catheter, Foley-type, 3-way, for continuous irrigation (A4316)	1	
Insertion tray with drainage bag but without catheter (A4354)	1	
Bedside drainage bag, day or night, with or without anti-reflux device, with or without tube, each (A4357)	2	
Urinary leg bag; vinyl, with or without tube, each (A4358)	2

The following table lists the quantity of supplies that may be considered medically necessary for intermittent catheterization:

**Table B: Supplies for Intermittent Catheterization**

Description	Quantities considered medically necessary per month
Lubricant, individual sterile packet, each (A4332)	200
Intermittent urinary catheter; straight tip, with or without coating (teflon, silicone, silicone elastomer, or hydrophilic, etc.), each (A4351)	200
Intermittent urinary catheter; coude (curved) tip, with or without coating (teflon, silicone, silicone elastomeric, or hydrophilic, etc.), each (A4352)	200
Intermittent urinary catheter, with insertion supplies (A4353)	200

Quantities in excess of those listed above will be considered not medically necessary.
